United in our Actions

Northern Dakota County Beyond the Yellow Ribbon (NDCBTYR) supported a local Veteran with a boiler installation. We received a call from Minneapolis-St. Paul Plumbing, Heating and Air (MSP) in January about a Veteran, who was a resident of St. Paul, and the boiler had gone out in their home. This took place during the coldest week of January, and the family was not in a financial position to pay for a new boiler system. The man of the house is a Veteran of six years of army reserve duty. Although the Veteran resided outside of our territory, the board quickly determined that during this cold spell we could not abandon a Veteran, and we authorized MSP to proceed with a new boiler. MSP reduced the price of the boiler from \$12,500 down to \$7,000 and NDCBTYR committed to the expense. Our board member Glenn Boche did some research on the City of St. Paul, and found that they had a Yellow Ribbon organization, so Ed Iago reached out. The St. Paul Yellow Ribbon group generously offered to join us in paying for this Veteran's new boiler, and donated \$3,500 to the expense. The photograph taken after the installation of the boiler shows members of the St. Paul Yellow Ribbon, members of MSP, along with the Chair of the NDCBTYR, Neil Garlock. NDCBTYR has now established a relationship with the St. Paul Yellow Ribbon and we look forward to more joint ventures in assisting Veterans and members of their family. We thank MSP for contacting us, and the generous reduction of their cost to assist a Veteran and his wife in a time of need.
