BLOCK PARTY PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

IT IS HEREBY AGREED:

The applicant agrees to abide by all rules set forth below, together with all ordinances and regulations that may be imposed governing such activities. Seventy-five percent of all impacted properties must consent to the road closure. Impacted properties are those properties that would have to find an alternative route if the street was closed.

1. **Barricades** Traffic barricades can be picked up at the Mendota Heights Public Works facility located at 2431 Lexington Ave South. The hours of pickup and return are 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. For weekend use, the pickup is on Friday and the return on Monday. On holidays, the pickup day would be the first working day preceding the holiday, with the return on the first working day following the holiday. Weekday pickup days are the day before and return the day after. No delivery or pickup of cones will be provided by the City.
2. **Traffic** The total roadway portion of the right-of-way shall be barricaded. Motorized vehicles will not be permitted access/passage to any portion of the barricaded street. Barricades shall be temporarily removed for authorized or emergency vehicles only. Items such as picnic tables, inflatable “bounce” play items, etc. that cannot be moved quickly for emergency vehicle passage shall not be placed on the roadway.
3. **Surface of Street** No materials of any type (such as powder, sawdust etc.) shall be placed on the public right-of-way.
4. **Supervision** Applicants shall maintain adult supervision at all times during the event.
5. **Clean-up** Applicant shall provide trash receptacles to prevent littering. Applicant shall be responsible for the pick-up and proper disposal of trash by noon the day following the block party.
6. **Speakers** No loud speaker system shall produce sounds audible outside the areas designated for the block party. Residents and guests shall fully comply with the city's Nuisance Ordinance (Title 4, Chapter 1)
7. **Compliance** The Mendota Heights Police Department is authorized to terminate any event which does not comply with the above requirements, the other city ordinances affecting public peace and safety
